

# Room Measurement Guide for Furniture

## Steps:

**Measure Wall Lengths:** Use a measuring tape to determine the length of each wall. Round to the nearest inch for precision.

- 1. Measure Door and Window Widths:** Record the width of each door and window. This is crucial for ensuring furniture can fit through doors and windows.
- 2. Space Between Windows and Walls:** Measure the distance between each window and the adjacent walls to plan for window treatments and avoid blocking natural light.
- 3. Ceiling Height:** Note the height of the room, especially if you plan to include tall furniture items or hanging fixtures.
- 4. Plan Layout and Walkways:** Consider the placement of furniture, ensuring there's enough space for movement and that the room doesn't feel overcrowded.
